



Get more money back from the IRS!

If your family earned less than \$53,505 last year, you may qualify for over \$6,000 in credit or cash back from the IRS through the Earned Income Tax Credit - or EITC.

You can qualify even if you don't owe taxes, but you must file a tax return to receive a payment. Here are the basics:

Qualifying Children	For Single/Head of Household or Qualifying Widow(er), Income Under	For Married Filing Jointly, Income Must be Less Than	You May Receive Up to
No Child	\$14,880	\$20,430	\$506
One Child	\$39,296	\$44,846	\$3,373
Two Children	\$44,648	\$50,198	\$5,572
Three or More	\$47,955	\$53,505	\$6,269

Eligibility is based on several factors, but 4 out of 5 people who apply will receive credit. Use the IRS's online EITC Assistant at www.irs.gov/eitc to see if you qualify. (A Spanish version is available.)

You earned it. Now file, claim it and get it.

Free Tax Return Preparation Assistance

The IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA) and the Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE) Programs offer free tax help for taxpayers who qualify.

Trained volunteers can help with special credits, such as Earned Income Tax Credit, Child Tax Credit, and Credit for the Elderly or the Disabled. Most sites also offer free electronic filing (e-filing) for faster refunds.
